

## **Post Op Instructions for Root Canal Therapy**

- 1. Refrain from chewing on root canal treated tooth for approximately 1 week as it will be sore. It is advisable to not use treated tooth to chew on harder foods until crown is placed on tooth as it could fracture.
- 2. Some swelling is possible, especially if tooth is infected. If an antibiotic was given take as directed. Let Dr. Watson know if there is any swelling.
- 3. For discomfort, use over-the-counter medications first. If a pain reliever was prescribed and the over-the-counter medications are not working, then take prescribed medications as instructions say. Do not drive or use alcohol in conjunction with narcotic medications as they can cause drowsiness.
- 4. Most root canal treated teeth will need a crown once the root canal is completed. Be sure you follow up on this treatment in order to prevent a crack or fracture in tooth.
- 5. Please let Dr. Watson know if there are any unusual symptoms.
